

## GUIDELINES FOR TRAVEL ANTHOLOGY 2020

NCPA is currently accepting submissions for their 3rd anthology. If interested in submitting an original story for publication with other NCPA authors, read the guidelines below.

- All entries must be the author's own original work.
- If story is printed elsewhere, Author must have all copyrights. To be entered in this Anthology, please submit a signed waiver to that effect.
- Submissions must be written in English, submitted by **Word Doc attachments, not pdf.**
- Theme of this publication is TRAVEL. Any genre, any type, anywhere, any planet, on land, on the sea, in the air, and everywhere!
- Multiple submissions are not permitted. However, if you receive a rejection before the deadline, you may submit a new story.
- Must be an NCPA member in good standing. To join (\$40/year) go to [norcalpa.org](http://norcalpa.org)

### Submission:

- Word length: 500 to 3000 words
- **Send in Word Doc attachment only, NOT PDF**
- Complete application and include with your submission.
- Read and sign contract/ agreement for publication. Include with your submission.
- 150-word Bio max, Book Titles included in count.
- **Jpg/jpeg author photograph, JPG/JPEG ONLY, and no text, please.**
- Biography of yourself
  - Include:
    - City you live in
    - Previous works written or published (**italicized, please**)
    - Your website address
    - Email address (optional)
- Manuscript format:
  - Garamond Font  
12pt.
  - Single-spaced.
  - Submit by Word Doc attachment ~ NO PDF
